Hermeneutics **2 units**

Study of the methods of interpretation of the Scriptures. A part of a Christian minister's qualification is to be "a workman who correctly handles the word of truth." Pastors must be honest and skillful in the interpretation of the Scriptures. This course will cultivate that ability.

Dogmatics 4: Doctrine of Christ **3 units**

Study of the Person and Work of Jesus Christ. This is the central focus of Scripture-revelation. No one knows the Bible who does not know Jesus Christ. No one can truly preach unless, like Paul, he can say, "We do not preach ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord" (2Cor. 4:5). Who is He as a Person of the Godhead? What is His nature before, during, and after the incarnation? What is He now in relation to the Christian? This doctrine is the heart and soul of the ministry of the Word of God.

Polemics **2 units**

Study and refutation of heresies and aberrant movements that influence the Evangelical church. Part of a Christian minister's qualification is that he is able "by sound doctrine, to exhort and convict those who contradict" (Titus 1:9). This course will cultivate that ability.

Languages: Hebrew & Greek **2 units**

Study of the original languages of the Bible. An ability to read Hebrew and Greek and knowledge of the fundamental parts of speech is the basic goal. The course is not addressed to would-be scholars entailing strenuous demands. It is for pastors and teachers whose ministries will profit from knowing how to do research on the original languages of God's Word.

Christian History: Modern Church 1 **2 units**

Study of the modern history of the church and developments in Christendom after the 16th century Reformation. To get a grip of the situation in which we minister, we need to understand the tides and flow of the last three-hundred years. It will add profoundly to our perspective of modern Christianity. It should sharpen our tools in ministering the Word of God to our times.

Modular Course: Pentateuch **2 units**

Study of the Pentateuch. It begins with the conviction that these five books are God's revelation to Moses. They are authentic history and carry God's message. This course will explore the themes that open the history of revelation. It will pay attention to the most significant passages. It will bring out the message that the author intended. The students will be trained expound this Scripture honestly, and will be equipped to preach its message to contemporary church life.
