Dogmatics 1:

3 units

Doctrine of the Word of God

Study of the doctrine of the Scripture. Reformed theology stands on the conviction of *Sola Scriptura*. Every Evangelical doctrine stands on our understanding of the infallibility and authority of the Bible. Pastors cannot be without knowledge of this vital truth. This course will address current trends that compromise the *Sola Scriptura* principle. It will also help to positively apply this doctrine to the contemporary church and Christian life.

Pauline Theology

2 units

Study of the theology of Paul. One of the most important advances in the field of New Testament study is in the theology of the great Apostle to the Gentiles. This course will grapple with the most important contributions to the subject of past and current scholarship. It will guide in the understanding and appreciation of the great themes of Paul's letters. It should prove to be a vital help for the pastor in his use of Paul in teaching and preaching.

Modular Course: OT - Minor Prophets

Study of the Minor Prophets - from Hosea to Malachi. The importance of these books cannot be over-estimated. They are not "minor" in that sense. These books cover the periods of the divided kingdom through the Exilic period and initial return to the Land. Prophetic pronouncements here are an essential source for understanding the history of redemption, thus, an invaluable material for biblical theology. The students will be trained and equipped to preach its message to contemporary church life.

Languages: Hebrew & Greek

2 units

Study of the original languages of the Bible. An ability to read Hebrew and Greek and knowledge of the fundamental parts of speech is the basic goal. The course is for pastors and teachers whose ministries will profit from knowing how to do research on the original languages of God's Word.

Christian History: Early Church

2 units

Survey of the history of Christianity in its general development in the early centuries. It is crucial to know of the Apostolic Fathers and the Church Fathers, the early heresies and persecutions. Emphasis will be put on major events and movements that have a lingering impact on modern Christianity.

Christian Ethics 1

2 units

Study of the Christian basis, approach, and position on ethical issues. What is the moral standard that is truly Christian, and from which we address ethical issues in the area of personal relations, life, society - and many more? As the pastor must be a good theologian, so he must be a good ethicist. We must avoid being indifferent to moral questions of today. But we must not simply conform to traditional answers. Christians have a surer foundation to answer the question, "What is right?"

New Testament: Romans

2 units

Second part of the study of Romans (chs. 9 - 16). Anyone seeking to have a sharp mind in theology must have a solid grasp of Romans. This course will guide students to an honest understanding of this letter to the end that they may preach and teach its contents to the profit of the church.
